Implication of our establishment in the Green development

Being of European origin and made sensitive very young in the environmental problems (very high cost of the electricity and the water in France), we decided, this year, to participate in the program RéserVert developed by the AHQ. It is the formula which allows the hotelkeepers to take in hand their evolution towards the Green development in a autonomous way. We are convinced that we have to make something to save our planet and bequeath to the future generations, a comfortable and healthy living space. We applied numerous ecological solutions to protect our site and our environment.

- Recovery of piles, paper, glass and plastic
- Heating of the swimming pool by the solar energy
- Use of compact fluorescent bulbs

Society Sector

- Purchase of local products for breakfasts
- Incitement of the clientele to discover the local activities
- Partnership with local participants for the activities of leisure (Kanatha Aki, National park of Mont Tremblant)
